GENERAL RULES

1. Refer to General Rules and Regulations for Animal Health Requirements. **NO ABSCESSSES.**
2. The Fair official shall check all registration or recordation papers for ownership, age, correct class entry, and identify the animal prior to entry into show ring.
3. Junior doe and senior doe shows are not sanctioned separately. Show to be held on Friday after 4-H Goats showing is completed, which starts @ 9:00 A.M.
4. The name of Sire and/or Dam shall be given for group classes.
5. Animals which are to be shown in group classes must have been shown in their individual classes.
6. **ALL GROUP CLASSES MUST BE LISTED ON ENTRY FORM WHEN TURNED IN TO SUPERINTENDENT.**

7. ALL MILKING DOES MUST BE VERIFIED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT TO HAVE BEEN STRIPPED DRY BETWEEN 6 P.M. AND 7 P.M. THE NIGHT BEFORE JUDGING.

8. All exhibitors are limited to not more than three entries per lot per breed.

9. Ribbons will be awarded for Herdsmanship for the first three places. Premiums for Herdsmanship:

1st \$15.00 2nd \$10.00 3rd \$5.00

Herdsmanship awards will be given at the discretion of the judges and will be based on the following score card:

SCORE CARD

- Animals – Arrangement, cleanliness and grooming, bedding, regularity of feeding 30%
- Stalls – Arrangement of equipment and supplies, cleanliness of equipment, supplies, stalls and alleys 20%
- Display Effects – Decorations, signs, stall cards 20%
- Educational Value of Exhibit 30%

TOTAL 100%

1. Entry fee will be \$3.00 per animal.
2. Milkstands to be used for milking/grooming and must be cleaned after each herd's use. **NO MILKING IN AISLES.**
3. Awards will be given as follows: 1st \$12.00, 2nd \$10.00; 3rd \$8.00; 4th \$7.00
4. Registered 4-H and FFA goats are eligible to exhibit in Open Class, and also must meet General Livestock Health Requirements.
